Grown from a carob pod in a sunny, Central Coast national park, Felicity Ward is a multi-award winning comedian, actor and writer who has toured her award-winning, sell-out shows across the world, winning hearts of audiences and critics everywhere she goes.

In Australia, Felicity has appeared on TV shows such as *Thank God You're Here, Have You Been Paying Attention, Spicks and Specks, The Ronnie Johns Half Hour, Ronny Chieng: International Student,* along with multiple appearances on the Melbourne International Comedy Festival Oxfam and Just For Laughs Sydney TV galas. Felicity has also appeared in two feature films, Any Questions For *Ben?* and *The Inbetweeners 2.* In 2021, she starred in the ABC dramedy, *Wakefield.*

Following the success of her 2014 ABC documentary, *Felicity's Mental Mission*, Felicity was handpicked by the BBC in 2015 as one of the new faces of UK comedy starring in her own *Live From The BBC* special - the only Australian selected. She is a regular face on many international TV shows including *Roast Battle* (UK), *The Stand Up Sketch Show* (UK), *The Mash Report* (UK), *Russell Howard's Good News* (UK), *Alan Davis' As Yet Untitled* (UK), *The John Bishop Show* (UK), *Mock the Week* (UK), *Gotham Comedy*



(US), Make You Laugh Out Loud (UK), Access All Areas (CAN) and Richard Osman's House of Games (UK).

Felicity is a Chortle UK Club Comic of the Year nominee and has been nominated for the biggest awards in live comedy, including Best Comedy at Edinburgh Festival Fringe, Melbourne International Comedy Festival and Adelaide Fringe, and has won Best Australian Act at the Perth Comedy Festival and Best Local Act at the Sydney Comedy Festival, twice.

In 2018, Felicity recorded her first BBC Radio 4 series, *Appisodes* and is a regular co-host of *The Guilty Feminist* podcast. Felicity was announced as the lead in the upcoming Aussie remake of *The Office*, set to air on Amazon in 2024.
