Consistently unpredictable, Harley projects the immediately recognisable and relatable image of the unpretentious Aussie male. Harley doesn't just use his instant likeability as a platform to deliver solid, topical material, he also gets beneath the nature of things to create a true bond with his audience and deliver an experience that will be talked about long after the gig is over.

Harley has appeared regularly on TV shows including *Hughesy*, *We Have A Problem* (TEN), *The Project* (TEN), *Best Bits* (SEVEN), *It's A Date* (ABC), *Celebrity Family Feud* (TEN), *Patriot Brains* (TVNZ 2/SBS), *Celebrity Letters and Numbers* (SBS), *7 Days* (TV3) and *Fisk* (ABC).

Harley co-hosted the popular weekly comedy/parenting podcast *Shitting With The Door Open* with Wade Duffin and a celebration of boutique brewing with *That's The Drink Talking* alongside fellow comic David Quirk.

In 2017, Harley co-hosted Sydney's 2Day FM Breakfast Show. He has a weekly segment on the Triple M Breakfast Show and pops up on other Triple M shows across the nation.

In 2019, Harley hosted the bold new TV series *Taboo* for Network Ten. This brave and beautiful show earned critical acclaim from far and wide, was nominated for a Logie and has been screened in several countries overseas.

In 2021, Harley co-hosted Ten Network's *Making It* and also joined Nikki Britton in the Nova podcast, *Mates Talking About Stuff*, which is currently in its third season - [click here to take a listen](#).
